Old Business:

1. April board meeting minutes were approved.
2. Friend raisers will take place on the first three Fridays of May.
3. Rhonda will take a college class next school year to keep her certification.
She is looking into a potential grant-writing class.

4. There is a UNC student working on a marketing presentation for Wee Love. Rhonda will provide additional information once she has seen the presentation.
5. The UPK seat adjustment for the 26-27 school year has been submitted to the state. The preschool will have the following seats:
 - Pre-K AM 5-day class: 15 students | We currently have 14 enrolled in this classroom
 - Pre-K AM 3-day class: 15 students | We currently have 8 enrolled in this classroom.
 - Pre-K PM 4-day class: 30 students | We currently have 2 enrolled in this classroom.

Total Spots: 75 | Currently filled 32 spots (6 more since the last board meeting).

New Business:

1. Instead of Lifetouch, the preschool has opted to utilize a small local business for photography services for the 2026-2027 school year. The anticipated cost per household for images is \$20 dollars. The photographer, Jasmine Marquez, is also the parent of one of our students.
2. Rhonda applied for four grants, totaling \$19,000. Two of those grants would be used for business expenses, and the other two would be for specific items, such as teacher laptops.
3. Prospective 2026-2027 parents shared that they selected Wee Love as their child's preschool because ChatGPT recommended the school.
4. The board voted on whether to hire Meghan as a part-time teacher for the 2026-2027 school year. The vote passed.
5. The end-of-year program will be split into two different nights on May 19th for PK Classes, and May 20th for the Beginner Class.
6. Summer Friend-raisers will be scheduled throughout the summer. The board will assist with attendance at these functions.
7. The next board meeting is scheduled for July 6, 2026, at 5:30 pm.
